

GIFTS ON DEATH ---- LEGACIES

Legacies are an extremely tax effective way of supporting charities:

They cost NOTHING in your lifetime.

They are exempt from inheritance tax, which at the moment is 40%.

Once you have provided in your will for your family and friends, could we ask you to consider making a legacy to the Shropshire Regimental Museum?

If you decide to help us by this method, you should ask your solicitor to make a codicil to your will leaving a legacy to *The Shropshire Regimental Museum*.

The following form of words may be useful:

" I GIVE the sum of £_____ [figures] _____ [words]

to THE SHROPSHIRE REGIMENTAL MUSEUM [REGISTERED CHARITY NUMBER 294260] AND I DIRECT that the receipt of the treasurer or other officer of the said museum shall be a good discharge to my Executors."

NOTE : Whilst there is no requirement to do so, it would be helpful to the Museum if you would also complete the form below giving details of your intended legacy and return it to the Treasurer. This would be for information purposes only and will be treated with total discretion.
